
## ALUMINUM REAR FENDER LINERS 2007-18 JEEP WRANGLER JK 2 AND 4-DOOR



## PROCEDURE:

## REMOVE CONTENTS FROM BOX. VERIEY ALL PARTS ARE PRESENT. READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY. ASSISTANCE IS RECOMMENDED.

- Start installation on the passenger/right side of the vehicle. Remove the plastic liner if equipped, (Figure 1). NOTE: Fender Liners are designed to be installed with Steelcraft and most aftermarket fenders only. Install fender before installing Liner(Figure 2).
- 2. Release the clip attaching the breather at the rear of the wheel opening, (Figure 3). Relocate the breather for clearance to install liner.
- 3. Select the passenger/right rear Fender Liner. Insert the Liner over the tire and back into position behind body panel. **NOTE**: It may be slightly easier to install Liner with vehicle raised and tire removed.
- 4. Attach the top of the Liner to the (2) holes in the body and aftermarket fender with (2) 6mm x 20mm Hex Bolts, (2) 6mm Lock Washers and (2) 6mm Flat Washer, (Figures 4 & 5). NOTE: Mounting holes in the Fender Liner line up with existing holes in the body panel and aftermarket fenders. Leave hardware loose at this time.
- Attach the bottom of the Liner to the mounting holes in the body with (2) 6mm Hex Bolts, (4) 6mm Flat Washers, (2) 6mm Lock Washers and (2) 6mm Hex Nuts, (Figures 4 & 5). Do not tighten hardware.
- 6. Level and adjust Fender Liner and tighten at hardware.
- 7. Repeat **Steps 1—6** to attach the driver/left Fender Liner.
- 8. Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.

**To protect your investment**, Do not use any type of polish or wax that may contain abrasives that could damage the finish. Mild soap may be used to clean the Fender Liners.
