PROCEDURE:

REMOVE CONTENTS FROM BOX. VERIFY ALL PARTS ARE PRESENT. READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE STARTING INSTALLATION. ASSISTANCE IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED TO AVOID POSSIBLE INJURY OR DAMAGE TO THE VEHICLE.

- 1. Remove the license plate and the (2) factory bolts behind the license plate, (Figure 1).
- 2. Unplug all wiring harnesses leading to the bumper, (Figure 2). Unplug the trailer plug, (Figure 3).
- 3. Place blocks or jack stands under the bumper to support it during mounting bolt removal. Assistance is highly recommended to remove the bumper. Starting on the passenger/right side, remove the factory bolt attaching the side of the bumper to the bumper support bracket, (Figure 4). Remove the (2) factory flange nuts attaching the bumper to the frame, (Figure 5). Repeat this Step to remove the factory hardware on the driver/left side. With assistance, pull bumper straight out from vehicle.
- 4. Move the OE rear bumper to stable surface. Unplug and remove the sensors, wiring harness, trailer plug, license lights, remote antenna with TPMS assembly bracket & the spare tire access lock, as equipped, from the bumper, (Figures 6–8).
- 5. Determine if the vehicle is equipped with parking sensors, cross traffic sensors and remote antenna. NOTE: Sensors and antenna must be installed before installing bumper.
 - Models without bumper parking sensors:
 - a. Select the included (4) Plastic Plugs.
 - b. Push plugs into sensor mounting holes, (Figure 9).

Models with bumper mounted parking sensors:

- **a.** Remove the silicone seal from the end of the sensor. Slide the included Foam Washer over front of sensor, (Figure 10).
- b. Attach (1) Foam Spacer to end of sensor, (Figure 11).

- **c.** Slide the sensor into the sensor mount on the back of the Bumper. Push and lock the Retaining Cap onto the sensor mount, (**Figure 11**).
- **d.** Repeat the above steps for each remaining parking sensor.

Models with Tire Pressure Monitoring System (TPMS):

- a. Select the factory remote antenna with TPMS assembly, (Figure 12).
- b. Push the (3) clips on the TPMS assembly into the slots in the mounting tabs, (Figure 13).

Models without cross traffic sensors:

- **a.** Select the driver/left Cover Mounting Bracket. Insert the Bracket into the pocket in the driver/left end of the Bumper, (Figure 14).
- b. Select (1) Plastic Cover. Attach the Cover to the outside of the Bracket with the included (4) 6mm x 20mm Button Head Bolts, (4) 6mm Flat Washers, (4) 6mm Lock Washers and (4) 6mm Hex Nuts, (Figure 15).
- **c.** Attach Bracket with Cover to the pocket with the included (3) 6mm x 20mm Hex Bolts, (6) 6mm Flat Washers, (3) 6mm Lock Washers and (3) 6mm Hex Nuts, **(Figure 17)**.

d. Repeat to install the Bracket with Plastic Cover on the passenger/right side of the Bumper.

Models with cross traffic sensors

- **a.** Select the driver/left Cover Mounting Bracket. Insert the Bracket into the pocket in the driver/left end of the Bumper, (Figure 14).
- b. Select (1) Plastic Cover. Attach the cover to the outside of the Bracket with the included (4) 6mm x 20mm Button Head Bolts, (4) 6mm Flat Washers, (4) 6mm Lock Washers and (4) 6mm Hex Nuts, (Figure 15). Slide the Bracket with Cover to the rear of the pocket to provide room to install sensor.
- **c.** Insert the driver/left sensor into the forward end of the pocket, **(Figure 16)**. Attach the sensor to the mounting locations on the pocket with (2) 6mm x 20mm Hex Bolts, (4) 6mm Flat Washers, (2) 6mm Lock Washers and (2) 6mm Hex Nuts, **(Figure 16)**.
- d. Slide the Bracket with Cover forward in the pocket and in front of the sensor. Attach the Bracket with Cover to the mounting locations on the pocket with the included (3) 6mm x 20mm Hex Bolts, (6) 6mm Flat Washers, (3) 6mm Lock Washers and (3) 6mm Hex Nuts, (Figure 17).
- e. Repeat the previous Steps to to install the Bracket with Plastic Cover and sensor on the passenger/right side of the Bumper.
- 6. Push the included License Plate Light and (2) Plastic Plugs into the holes in the bumper, (Figure 18).
- 7. Snap the trailer plug & spare tire access lock into the openings in the Rear Bumper, (Figure 18).
- 8. Install the factory harness into the back of the Bumper. **NOTE:** Run the wire harness over the light mounting tabs on the back of the Bumper to avoid any interference with the exhaust. Plug the sensors, license light & remote antenna with TPMS assembly into the harness. **NOTE:** If necessary, cut the electrical tape on the wire harness to extend the reach to sensors. Reapply housing around harness.
- 9. Remove the (2) bumper support brackets from the frame, (Figure 19).
- **10.** Temporarily support the weight of the Bumper. **WARNING**: To avoid possible injury or damage to the vehicle, do not proceed until the Bumper is fully and safely supported. With assistance, position the Bumper Assembly up to the frame.
- **11.** Determine the model of the vehicle.

1500 models:

Use the **OUTER SLOTS** in the bumper mounting bracket on the back of the Bumper to attach the Bumper to the end of the frame with (4) 12mm x 40mm Hex Bolts, (8) 12mm Flat Washers and (4) 12mm Nylon Lock Nuts, **(Figure 20)**.

25-3500 models:

Use the **INNER SLOTS** in the bumper mounting bracket on the back of the Bumper to attach the Bumper to the end of the frame with (4) 12mm x 40mm Hex Bolts, (8) 12mm Flat Washers and (4) 12mm Nylon Lock Nuts, **(Figure 21)**.

- **12.** Level and adjust the bumper and fully tighten all hardware. Slowly open tailgate and check for clearance. Adjust as necessary.
- **13.** Plug all wire harnesses & trailer plug into the vehicle harness, (Figure 22).
- **14.** Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.

To protect your investment, Do not use any type of polish or wax that may contain abrasives that could damage the finish. Mild soap may be used to clean the Bumper assembly.
