

PROCEDURE:

REMOVE CONTENTS FROM BOX. VERIFY ALL PARTS ARE PRESENT. READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE STARTING INSTALLATION. MINOR PLASTIC TRIMMING MAY BE REQUIRED. INSTALLATION MAY INTERFERE WITH BUMPER MOUNTED PARKING SENSORS. ASSISTANCE IS RECOMMENDED.




(Fig 1) Open hood and temporarily remove hood release lever

- 1. Open the hood and remove the hood release lever, (Figures 1 & 2). Remove the plastic pins and cover from the top of the grille and radiator. Temporarily reattach the lever.
- 2. Remove the now exposed hardware attaching the top of the grille to the body.
- **3.** Loosen plastic body panels, (fascia panels):


(Fig 3a) 2020-23 Models: Firmly pull fascia body panels up and straight out to release from clips next to grille (passenger side pictured-also see Figure 4)

 - **2020-2023 Models:** Grab and pull panel between the top of the bumper and the bottom of the headlight, **(Figure 3a). NOTE:** Fascia panels do not need to be fully removed, only loosen the insides to remove the grille.
 - **2024-on Models:** Starting at the front of the wheel well, remove the 2 screws attaching the fender liner to the fascia panels. Grab plastic fender flare and pull to release plastic pins securing the plastic fender flare to body, **NOTE:** flare does not need to be fully removed, only the first few pins. Remove the now exposed small hex bolt attaching fascia to body **(Figure 3b)**.
- **4.** On models with grille mounted camera, unplug harness leading to the camera.

- **5.** Once all attaching screws and clips have been removed, pull grille straight out to release from clips, **(Figure 4)**.
- 6. Remove the hex bolt from the top of the driver/left side of the frame, (Figure 5).
- 7. Identify the correct Top Mounting Bracket for your model year: Select the driver/left Top Bracket and apply Foam Tape to bottom of the Bracket, (Figure 6). Use the factory hex bolt to attach the Top Bracket to the frame, (Figures 7a – 7b). Repeat this and the previous Step to attach the passenger/right Top Bracket. Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.
- **8.** Move to the bottom of the front bumper. Determine if the vehicle is equipped with tow hooks. **Models with tow hooks**.
 - **a.** Remove the driver/left tow hook and seal from bumper, **(Figures 8—10)**. Slide tow hook back into position.
 - b. Select the driver/left Frame Mounting Bracket and Support Bracket, (Figure 11). Slide the Frame Bracket through the tow hook opening and along the outside of the frame, (Figure 10). Insert (2) 10mm x 130mm Hex Bolts with (2) 10mm Flat Washers through the Bracket, frame and tow hook, (Figures 11 & 12).
 - c. Slide the Support Bracket over the hex bolts. Attach the Support Bracket to the inner facing side of the frame with (2) 10mm Flat Washers and (2) 10mm Nylon Lock Nuts, (Figures 11 & 13). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.
 - d. Attach the bottom of the Support Bracket to the Frame Bracket with the included (1) 12mm x 40mm Hex Bolt, (1) 12mm x 37mm Large Flat Washer, (frame bracket side), (1) 12mm x 24mm Small Flat Washer, (support bracket side) and (1) 12mm Nylon Lock Nut, (Figures 11 & 13). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.
 - e. Repeat these **Steps** to attach the passenger/right Brackets.


Models without tow hooks or if tow hooks will not be reinstalled

- **a. IMPORTANT**: The pocket in the plastic bumper may need to be cut out to clear the Frame Brackets, **(Figure 10)**. Use a sharp knife or hacksaw blade and carefully cut out the pocket to clear the Frame Brackets. Only cut out enough plastic to clear the Brackets.
- **b.** Insert (1) 10mm Double Bolt Plate into the open end of the frame and out through the outside of the frame.
- **c.** Slide the driver/left Frame Bracket through the opening in the bumper and over the threaded studs on the Bolt Plate, **(Figure 14)**.
- **d.** Attach the Frame Bracket to the Bolt Plate with (2) 10mm Flat Washers and (2) 10mm Nylon Lock Nuts, **(Figure 14)**.
- e. Repeat the previous **Steps** to attach the driver/left Support Bracket to the inner facing side of the frame, **(Figure 15)**. Attach the bottom of the Support Bracket to the Frame Bracket with the included (1) 12mm x 40mm Hex Bolt, (1) 12mm x 37mm Large Flat Washer, (frame bracket side), (1) 12mm x 24mm Small Flat Washer, (support bracket side) and (1) 12mm Nylon Lock Nut. Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.
- **f.** Repeat these **Steps** to attach the passenger/right Brackets.
- 9. With assistance, position the Heavy Duty Grille Guard up to the outside of the Mounting Brackets, (Figure 16). Attach the Grille Guard to the Frame Brackets with the included (4) 12mm x 40mm Hex Bolts, (8) 12mm x 37mm Large Flat Washers and (4) 12mm Nylon Lock Nuts, (Figures 17 & 18). Attach the Top Brackets to the inside of the Grille Guard with (2) 10mm x 35mm Hex Bolts, (4) 10mm Flat Washers and (2) 10mm Nylon Lock Nuts, (Figures 17 & 18). Do not fully tighten hardware.
- **10.** Level and adjust the Grille Guard and fully tighten all hardware attaching Brackets to vehicle only. Temporarily remove Grille Guard.

- **11.** Reinstall grille, fascia body panels and top cover. On models with camera, plug in wiring harness.
- 12. Reinstall Grill Guard and fully tighten all hardware.
- 13. On models with camera, remove screen from center of Grille Guard, (Figure 19).
- **14.** Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.


(Fig 3b) 2024-on: Firmly pull flare to expose hex bolt.

(Fig 4) Once both fascia body panels (arrows) have been loosened, remove grille




(Fig 5) From above, remove factory bumper bracket bolt (arrow)




(Fig 7a) 2020-23 models: Reuse bumper bracket bolt to attach Driver/left Top Mounting Bracket to top of frame




(Fig 7b) 2024-on: Reuse bumper bracket bolt to attach Driver/left Top Bracket to top of frame

(Fig 9) Remove tow hook and foam seal (driver/left pictured)




(Fig 10) Reinsert tow hook. Insert driver/left outer Frame Bracket through opening and along outside of frame






(Fig 12) Attach driver/left Frame Bracket to outside of frame (pictured from below bumper)



(Fig 13) Attach driver/left inner Support Bracket to inner facing side of frame




(Fig 15) Models without tow hooks, insert Double Bolt Plate into frame and out through holes. Attach driver/left inner Support Bracket to Double Bolt Plate. Attach Support Bracket to bottom of Frame Bracket




(Fig 14) Models without tow hooks, insert Double Bolt Plate into frame and out through holes. Attach driver/left Frame Bracket to Double Bolt Plate


(Fig 16) Brackets installed. Do not reinstall grille until after Grille Guard has been installed, Brackets adjusted and hardware tightened to frame only (Step 10, Fig 18)




(Fig 17) Attach Grille Guard to outside of Brackets
